DHL IMPACT PLAYER AWARD

A rugby player produces moments of skill and flair that are critical to a team's success on the pitch, in the same way that DHL uses care and commitment to service your shipments.

The DHL Impact Player Award recognises such moments using a statistical analysis of individual players' performances measured against four key criteria - Off-Loads, Carries, Line-breaks and Tackles.

On execution of these skills during a match, points are awarded – Offloads 2 points, Tackles 1 point, Line Breaks 3 points, Carries 1 point – to create a total score which is tracked through the DHL Impact Player table.


To all the visiting international teams, I would like to extend a warm welcome to sunny Singapore.

Canada's team roster for Singapore is infused with young talent, many of whom made their debuts when the series made its stop in Malaga. The team has been hard in training to prepare for a series of tournaments in April: the 2022 RAN Sevens Qualifiers, Singapore Sevens followed by the Vancouver Sevens. The National Stadium holds fond memories for the Canadians. In 2017, they beat rivals USA 26 - 19 to clinch their first-ever tournament win on the Series.

Post the Tokyo Olympics, the England 7s is going through a period of transition and looking at the HSBC World Rugby Sevens Series as a key opportunity for them to mould and build the team for future successes. The team is going from strength to strength having finished third in the Malaga Sevens in January. England's best finish in the HSBC World Rugby Sevens Series is second place, which they have achieved four times, most recently in the 2016 - 17 season.
